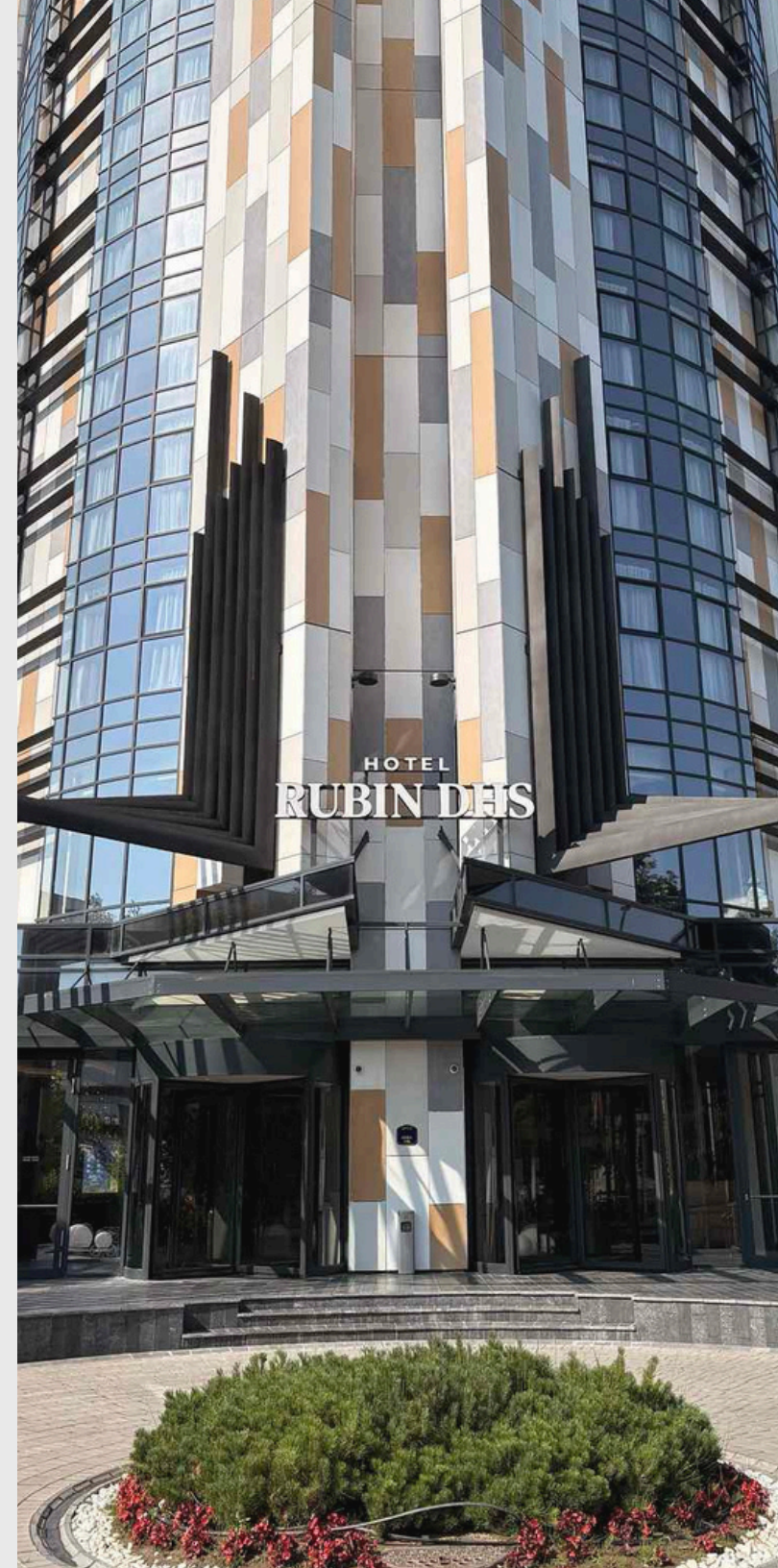
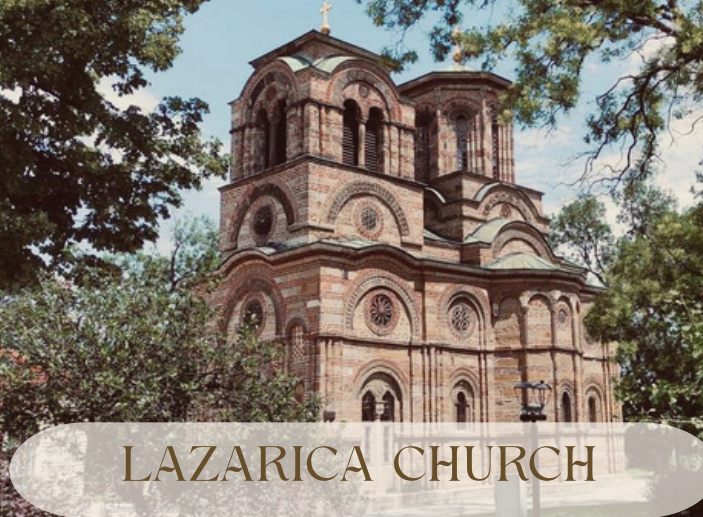


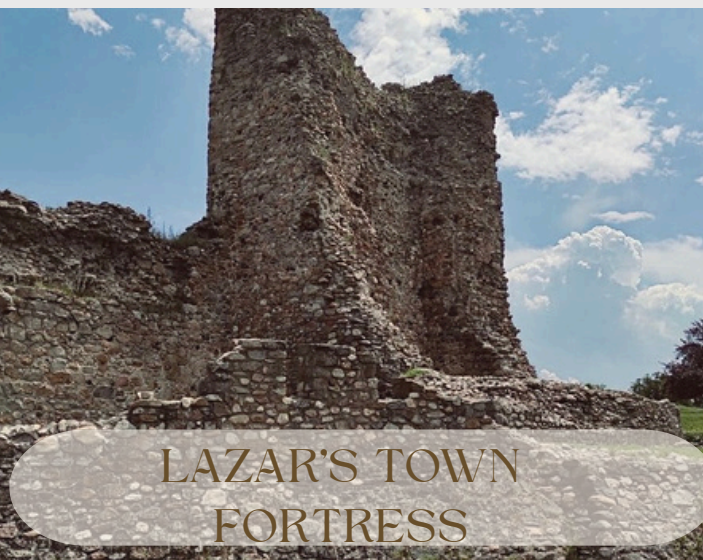
## WELCOME TO THE HOTEL RUBIN DHS 4\*

## MONUMENT TO KOSOVO HEROES

## DESPOT STEFAN LAZAREVIĆ

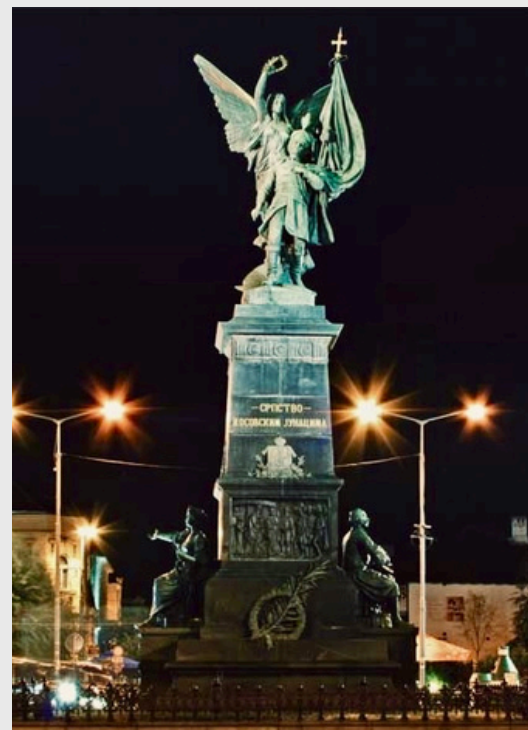

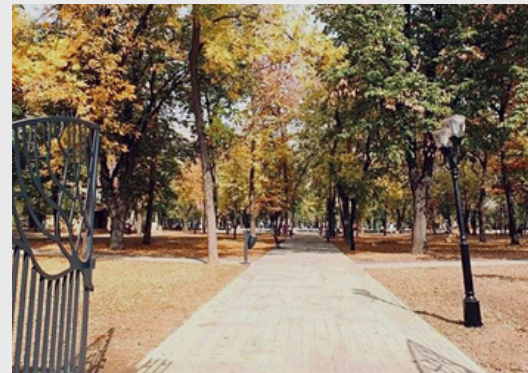
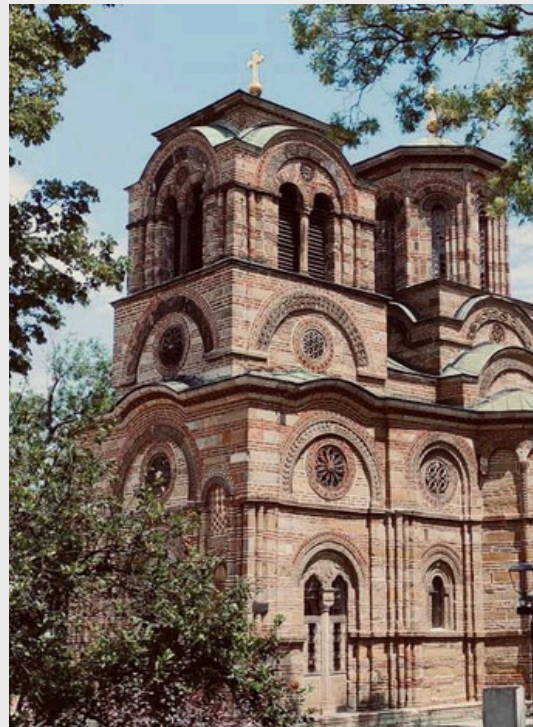


## HISTORICAL SITES

Once the capital of medieval Serbia, Lazar's Town was founded in the 14th century by Prince Lazar. This fortified complex, featuring medieval walls, towers, and the impressive Donjon Tower, is the city's most significant archaeological site. Together with the Monument to Prince Lazar and the nearby Lazarica Church, it offers visitors a fascinating insight into Serbia's rich historical heritage.

## PARKS & NATURE

Pionirski Park is a green oasis in the city center, ideal for relaxation and leisurely walks. Friendship Park is a modern urban park known for its pleasant atmosphere and the popular "I Love Kruševac" landmark. Bagdala Hill is one of the city's favorite recreational areas, offering panoramic views and the unique Serbia Miniature Park. Slobodište Memorial Park is a peaceful memorial complex dedicated to the victims of World War II, combining history, remembrance, and natural beauty.





## KRUŠEVAC THEATRE

Founded in 1946, Kruševac Theatre is the cultural heart of the city. It offers a rich programme of drama, comedy, and contemporary performances, celebrating Serbian theatrical tradition and nurturing local artistic talent throughout the year.



## ART GALLERIES

The City Hall Gallery houses works by master painter Milić Stanković, while the Art Gallery — set in an early 20th-century building — showcases Serbian and international artists. The Milić of Mačva Gallery is dedicated to this celebrated Serbian painter's visionary works.



## NATIONAL MUSEUM

The National Museum of Kruševac preserves the city's rich legacy through archaeological artifacts, historical exhibits, and ethnographic collections. Explore medieval treasures, folk costumes, and relics that trace Kruševac's role as Serbia's former royal capital.





## KOSTURNICA SQUARE

The heart of Kruševac's historic legacy, Kosturnica Square is adorned with the magnificent equestrian statue of Despot Stefan Lazarević and surrounded by monuments honoring the heroes of medieval Serbia. A place of memory, pride, and cultural gathering for the people of Kruševac.



## FOUNTAIN SQUARE

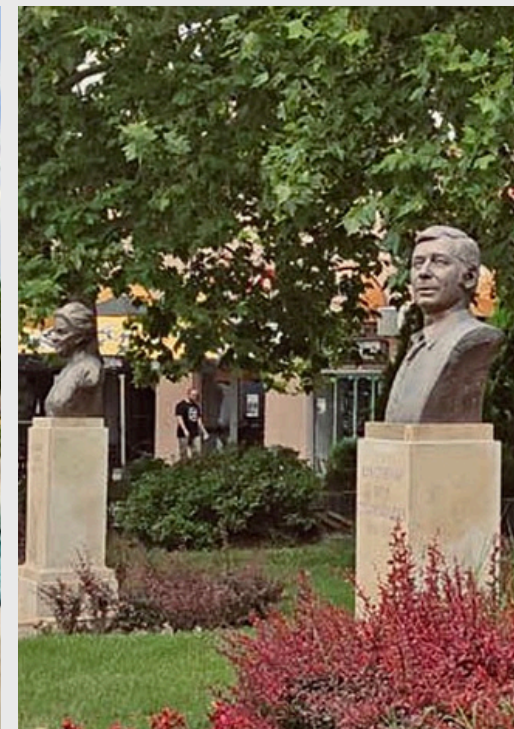

## LAZARICA CHURCH

A masterpiece of Serbian medieval architecture and the finest example of the Morava School style. Built by Prince Lazar in the 14th century, Lazarica is adorned with intricate stone carvings, ornate floral and geometric motifs, and sacred frescoes. A symbol of Serbian spiritual and artistic heritage.



## CHURCH OF HOLY VIRGIN

The Church of the Protection of the Holy Virgin on the Rasina River is a modern Orthodox church of great spiritual significance. Renowned for its rich iconography, sacred frescoes, and holy springs, this church draws pilgrims and visitors seeking both faith and tranquility along the banks of the Rasina.

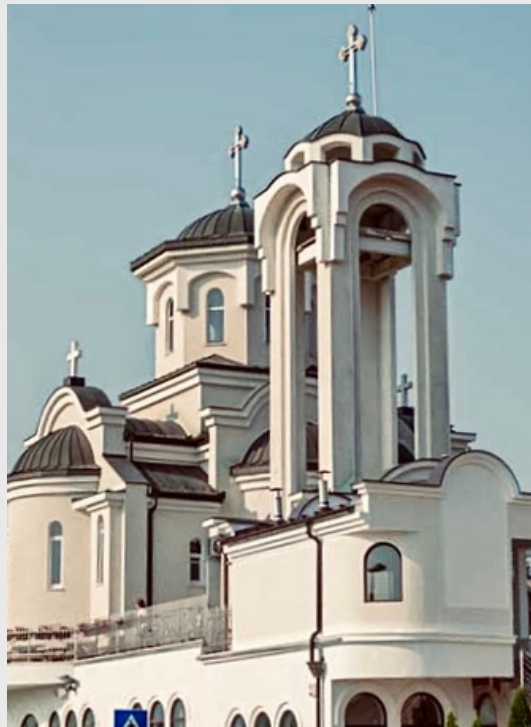


## SAINT ROMAN MONASTERY
